

Waterproof Matches with Clear Nail Polish!



Waterproofing matches with clear nail polish is the best way to waterproof matches! There's no wax to heat. They don't stick to each other in summer heat. You don't have to clean the tips of the matches to make sure they'll light. It's easy!

To waterproof a match, hold it by the bottom end and paint it with colorless nail polish. Blow on it until it dries. Set it down and do another one.

But before you do very many, test one of your matches to see if it will light! Some colorless nail polish will prevent a match from lighting. Don't know how to tell which colorless nail polish in advance, sorry!

When you've got a batch done, pick them up by their heads and paint their bottoms. After they are quite dry, store them in a match safe. Mark the container "Waterproof Matches."
